**Aynsley Bubbico** has appeared in numerous theatre, television, and film productions. As a vocalist, Aynsley has performed at The Kennedy Center and The American Singer Seminar at the Breckenridge Music Festival. **Jacqueline Obradors** is an actor who is currently recurring on the Emmy Award-winning series *Grey's Anatomy*, as well as the FOX hit drama *The Cleaning Lady*.
